INVITING YOU TO JOIN US FOR HAYDN'S "THE CREATION"

Dear Singing Friends,

I am writing today to invite you to be a part of Franz Joseph Haydn's glorious oratorio *The Creation*, and to encourage you to spread the word among your singing family, friends and colleagues.

Inspired by Handel's Messiah, Haydn's The Creation is considered by many the greatest oratorio ever composed, second only to Messiah itself. The majestic choruses are interspersed with some of the most intrinsically beautiful arias in all of music. The Summer Singers will perform this great work with a fully professional chamber orchestra, and with soloists Victoria Botero, Zachary Devin and Joshua Markley.

The piece will be sung in the wonderful English translation by Robert Shaw.

Rehearsals will be Tuesday evenings, 7:00-9:00, at Grace & Holy Trinity Cathedral in downtown Kansas City, beginning June 13. Our dress rehearsal with orchestra will be Saturday, August 19, 9:00-noon. The concert will be Sunday afternoon, August 20, at 2:00 PM, in the beautiful nave of the Cathedral.

As always, there will be no audition for participation in the 2023 Summer Singers of Kansas City. All adults and mature youth (16 & older) are invited to participate. Youth younger than 16 may participate if a parent or guardian is present with them at all times. The Summer Singers program is not recommended for youth below the age of 12.

If you have not been singing regularly in recent months, you might be concerned about getting your voice back in shape before joining Summer Singers rehearsal. Jamea Sale, PhD, Director of the Institute for Healthy Singing & Voice Research (IHS&VR), has been hard at work creating a series of instructions and exercises to address those very issues. There will be abundant resources offered as a part of Summer Singers membership, and there will be the option for joining in additional classes through IHS&VR.

Tuition for 2023 reflects a modest increase to account for inflation: \$95, or \$85 if <u>paid</u> by May 1. Students, and members of ACDA, AGO, MMEA, KMEA and/or NafME will enjoy an any-time tuition of \$65. This tuition helps cover the cost of staff, music scores, royalties, programs, orchestral musicians, promotion and concert production expenses. As a Core Value, the Choral Foundation will not deny participation to anyone because of inability to pay tuition. We do ask, however, that a request for tuition assistance ONLY be made if the need is truly genuine.

### Who is invited to participate in Summer Singers?

All adults regardless of their musical background are invited to sing. No audition is required. Mature youth in grades 9-12 are invited to participate. Youth under the age of 16 may participate only if a parent or guardian is a registered, participating member of the Summer Singers. Summer Singers is not recommended for youth under the age of 12.

### Where are rehearsals located?

All rehearsals and our performance will be at Grace & Holy Trinity Cathedral, Broadway at 13<sup>th</sup> Street in downtown KCMO. There is free off-street parking on the church property.

### What is the tuition, and where does the money go?

Tuition for the 2023 Summer Singers of Kansas City is \$95, or \$85 if paid before May 1. A special rate of \$65 is available for Students and Choral Directors (members of ACDA, AGO, MMEA, KMEA or NafME). Those electing to pay tuition early enable the Foundation to save money by making purchases in advance of need. The tuition helps fund the Choral Foundation, paying staff salaries, promotional mailings and announcements, printed materials and music scores. For the record, tuition payments and concert donations pay only a small portion of these expenses. The balance is made up by generous gifts to the Choral Foundation and the Summer Singers of Kansas City from individuals and organizations. Tuition is NOT refundable for any reason, but may be applied to any future Summer Singers if you are unable to participate.

### What is the Choral Foundation?

The Choral Foundation is a national arts organization founded in Atlanta in 1990. It is best known in Kansas City, where it is now headquartered, as the sponsoring organization for The William Baker Festival Singers and the Summer Singers of Kansas City, the Summer Singers of Lee's Summit, along with the Jane Sullivan Choral Resource Library and the Institute for Healthy Singing & Voice Research. In all, the twelve ensembles of the Choral Foundation will register over 600 men, women and youth in the course of the year. The Choral Foundation is a 501-c-3 tax exempt corporation of the State of Kansas, licenced to conduct business in Georgia and Missouri, and active in Illinois. ### What if I can't pay tuition?

The By-Laws and Core Values of the Choral Foundation (read them at www.ChoralFoundation.org) direct that no one will ever be denied the benefits of the Choral Foundation based on ability to pay. Full tuition assistance, partial tuition assistance and extended tuition payment arrangements are available upon request. We rely on an honor system and ask that singers make application ONLY in case of genuine need.

I would love to sing, but my family will be away on vacation and I might miss one or two rehearsals. The Summer Singers of Kansas City is, obviously, a "summer" chorus. We realize that summer is the vacation season and that most members will miss a rehearsal or two. We ask that every member do their very best to be present for all rehearsals possible and that, to the extent of their ability, every singer practices his/her music at home between rehearsals.

I sang in choir in high school and college, but I am WAY out of practice. Is there any program that will help me learn my music? Is my out-of-practice voice going to be a problem?

One of the great things about the Summer Singers is that it gives singers a chance to get their voices back in shape, or keep them in shape during the traditional off-season. Sectional rehearsals are held periodically to help singers learn their part. We would also recommend that singers purchase a recording of the scheduled works. Listening to a quality recording will help you understand how the parts fit together. It will also increase your excitement for the concerts.

May I enroll in both the Summer Singers of Lee's Summit and the Summer Singers of Kansas City? Yes! Of course. The Summer Singers of Lee's Summit will be performing Donald McCullough's deeply moving HOLOCAUST CANTATA and Amy Thropp's KADDISH FOR THE SIX MILLION. Rehearsals are Thursday nights in downtown Lee's Summit, beginning June 1, with dress rehearsal and concert, Saturday/Sunday, July 29/30. Tuition is the same. Enrolling in an additional summer chorus will require payment of tuition for the second program.

### What do singers wear for concerts?

Men are asked to wear a dark suit with a white shirt and a long dark tie. Women are asked to wear a black dress, or black blouse with black trousers. All are asked to wear black shoes. You do not need to purchase any attire for Summer Singers' concerts. Get as close as you can with items from your own closet. However, ALL SINGERS are asked to refrain from fragrances at ANY rehearsal or concert.
